




Pupil Learning Survey Results – May 2021









Do you like coming to school?

87% (34 children) of you said YES you like coming to school

13% (5 children) of you said you do not always like coming to school

Thank you for telling us how you feel. We are meeting regularly with those pupils who have answered not always, and we are working together to turn this into a yes.



Do you feel safe in school?

90% (35 children) of you said YES you always feel safe in school

10% (4 children) of you said you sometimes do not feel safe in school

Thank you for telling us how you feel, again we are working very closely with those 4 pupils who said they do not always feel safe in school. When we asked why they do not always feel safe their replies were:

- I miss my mum and I wish she were in school with me
- Sometimes I feel really tired
- When I play with my friends, sometimes I do not get to play the games I want to play
- There are some days when I want to be back learning at home



How do you find the work you are given?

8% of you said you find the work given to you was too hard

5% of you said you find the work given to you was too easy

87% of you said you find the work given to you was about right

We have listened to your feedback and we are delighted that most of you are now finding the work you are being given about right.

We will continue to ensure:

- 1. Our expectations for all our pupils remain high
- 2. We give learning purpose, meaning and clear outcomes
