Frida Kahlo Class visit to the Food Museum, Stowmarket

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to announce Frida Kahlo Class will be visiting the Food Museum (Stowmarket, Suffolk, IP14 1DL) on Wednesday 6th March 2024. This visit will be related to our topic called 'Ready Steady Grow'. This trip will give children fun and informative learning experiences that will help them understand the role that food has played in shaping our history and culture.

At the food museum, the children will learn how cheese is made to brewing tasty drinks and baking ancient breads. They will have the opportunity to understand how food brings communities together, find out its exciting history and even get their hands dirty with hands-on activities.

We aim to depart promptly at 9:00am, arriving at the park by 11:00am. We plan to return to school by 3:30pm. Children are required to wear their full school uniform for the trip (unless they attend nursery). Please make sure they are wearing appropriate comfortable footwear (e.g. trainers).

They will need a packed lunch, no fizzy drinks or unhealthy snacks please. If you prefer, you can opt for a school snack pack lunch by indicating your choice on the attached permission form.

Additionally, to ensure the comfort of our children during the journey, we will be making a scheduled toilet break at Scole Services on the way and Mcdonalds (Winterton Way, Norwich) on the return journey. This break will provide a chance for the children to stretch their legs and break up the length of the journey.

The cost of the trip is £10 per child. This is to cover the cost of the coach. In order to make school trips financially viable we ask for a contribution from parents/carers. This contribution would be the cost of the coach, entry fee to the venue and any activities or workshops per child. Please make payment via the Parentmail shop (no cash please). If parents/carers cannot make the full contribution due to financial restraints or their children are entitled to Free School Meals please contact the School Office or Mr Elcock

To make our trip a success, we kindly request the assistance of three parent volunteers. This will be a first come, first serve basis. If you are available and would like to join us, please indicate on the attached permission form and we will contact you.
